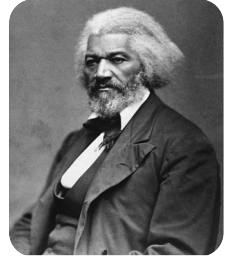


Antislavery Speech
