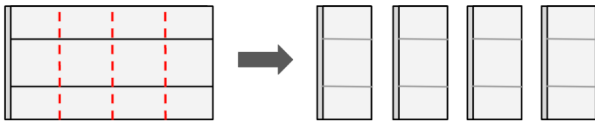
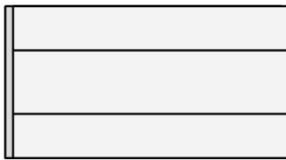


Beehive Model Preparation and Instructions

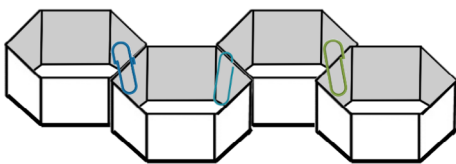
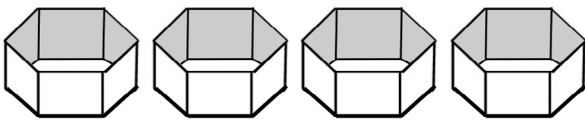
Instructions: Read the following instructions aloud to students as they are mentioned in the “Build a Hive” activity.

Before the lesson, prepare the craft for students:



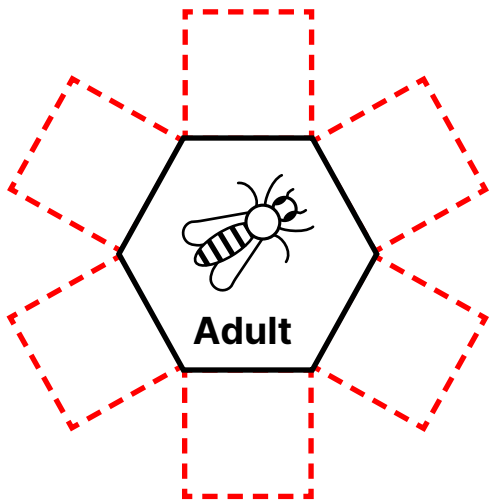
1. Turn each toilet paper tube so that it is oriented horizontally and flatten it.
2. Fold each tube twice horizontally to make two long creases.
3. Cut each tube three times vertically so that you have four equal pieces.

Instructions: Read the following instructions aloud to students as they are mentioned in the “Build a Hive” mini.



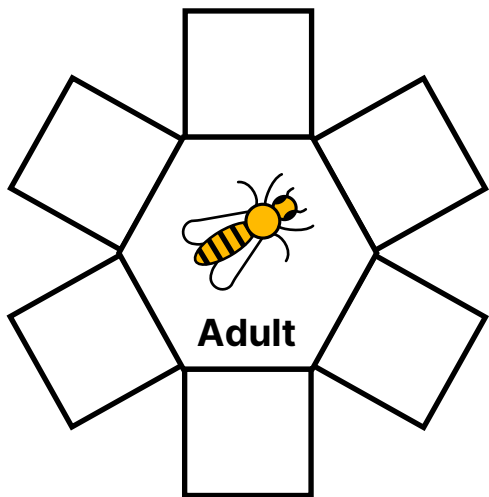
Part 1

1. Open up the pieces. These shapes, called hexagons, have six sides. These will be the cells in your hive.
2. Glue the pieces together so that they are in a line. Once you’ve glued the cells, clip them together with paper clips so they can dry.



Part 2

3. Cut out the shapes with the young bee pictures on them along the dotted lines. Don't cut on any of the solid lines!



Part 3

4. Take a minute to color in the young bees in each picture. If you need ideas, you can look at the pictures on the screen.
5. Pick up the egg picture and flip it over. Put glue on the tabs.
6. Then flip the egg picture back over and push it into the first cell so that the glued sides are on the walls of the cell. Push the glued sides to the cell so that they stick together.
7. Do the same thing for the other pictures. Make sure that the pictures are in order from youngest to oldest bee.
